

IMPLIEDLY

Meaning: Impliedly means in a manner that suggests or indicates something indirectly rather than explicitly.

1. The speaker impliedly suggested that changes were needed without stating it outright.
2. Her smile impliedly conveyed her approval of the decision made by the committee.
3. The report impliedly criticized the management for poor performance without naming anyone.
4. By not answering the question directly, he impliedly acknowledged his guilt in the situation.
5. The contract impliedly included terms that were not explicitly stated, which led to confusion later.
