2. The use of dark colors in the painting can imply a sense of foreboding.
3. His remarks about the project appeared to imply dissatisfaction with the team's efforts.
4. The study results imply a significant correlation between diet and mental health.
5. When she said she loved the city, it didn't imply that she wanted to stay forever.
