*Meaning: Impoliticly: in a manner that is unwise or tactless, often leading to negative consequences or alienation.*

1. She spoke impoliticly during the meeting, alienating several key stakeholders.
2. The politician's impoliticly worded remarks drew criticism from both allies and opponents.
3. By addressing the issue impoliticly, he inadvertently escalated the conflict rather than resolving it.
4. Her impoliticly blunt comments about the project's failure caught everyone off guard.
5. Responding impoliticly to the journalist's question only fueled the controversy surrounding the event.
