Meaning: Imposableness refers to the quality of being difficult or impossible to satisfy or fulfill, often leading to overwhelming or contentious situations.

1. The imposableness of her demands left the committee feeling overwhelmed and unsure of how to proceed.
2. His imposableness during negotiations turned what could have been a simple agreement into a contentious battle.
3. Despite the imposableness of the task at hand, she approached it with determination and grit.
4. The imposableness of their expectations often led to frustration among the team members.
5. In the face of his imposableness, she learned the importance of setting firm boundaries.
