Meaning: Imposer: a person who enforces or imposes their beliefs, rules, or opinions on others, often in a way that is perceived as authoritative or intrusive.

1. The new manager was seen as an imposer of strict rules that stifled creativity.
2. Her reputation as an imposer of her opinions often led to heated debates among her colleagues.
3. He felt like an imposer when he suggested changes that others were not ready to accept.
4. As an imposer of his beliefs, he struggled to find common ground with those who disagreed.
5. The artist was criticized for being an imposer of her vision, disregarding her collaborators' input.
