Meaning: Imposition refers to the act of establishing or enforcing something, such as rules or burdens, that is often seen as unwelcome or intrusive.

1. The imposition of new regulations sparked a heated debate among community members.
2. Many viewed the tax increase as an unnecessary imposition on their financial freedom.
3. The school's dress code was seen by some students as an imposition on their personal expression.
4. She felt that the constant imposition of deadlines negatively affected her creativity.
5. The imposition of strict rules in the workplace can sometimes lead to lower employee morale.
