2. The artist impostured the character of a tortured genius in his latest exhibition.
3. Despite his calm demeanor, he felt that he was impostured every time he spoke in public.
4. They impostured their credentials to secure a meeting with the influential investor.
5. In the film, the protagonist impostured her way into the enemy's stronghold under the guise of a diplomat.
