

IMPRESCRIPTIBLY

Meaning: IMPRESCRIPTIBLY: In a manner that cannot be lost, forfeited, or diminished over time, especially with regard to rights or principles that remain valid irrespective of legal changes.

1. The rights of the indigenous people were deemed imprescriptibly protected by the constitution.
