Meaning: IMPROPORTIONABLE: disproportionate or not in proper relation or balance to something else.

1. The costs of the project seemed improportionable to the benefits we expected to receive.
2. His reaction to the minor setback was improportionable, reflecting deeper issues he hadn't addressed.
3. In an improportionable manner, she attempted to solve the problem with excessive force rather than careful thought.
4. The improportionable allocation of resources led to significant disparities within the community.
5. She felt that the amount of time he spent on trivial tasks was improportionable to its actual importance.
