Meaning: IMPROPORTIONATE: (adjective) not in correct or appropriate proportion; excessively large or small in relation to something else.

1. The penalties imposed for minor infractions seemed impropportionate compared to the crime committed.
2. Her reaction to the news was impropportionate, causing concern among her friends.
3. The funding allocated to the project felt impropportionate given its actual scope and needs.
4. Many argued that the impropportionate distribution of resources exacerbated social inequalities.
5. His impropportionate enthusiasm for the small achievement surprised everyone in the room.
