Meaning: Improvisatize: to create or perform something spontaneously and without preparation, often in response to unexpected circumstances.

1. The musician had to improvisatize a new melody when the original one fell flat during the performance.
2. In her theater class, she learned to improvisatize her lines when the script didn't resonate with the audience.
3. When faced with unexpected challenges, he often had to improvisatize solutions on the spot.
4. The chef decided to improvisatize a dish with the leftover ingredients in the fridge.
5. During the meeting, she had to improvisatize her presentation after the technology failed.
