

IMPUNITY

Meaning: Impunity refers to the exemption from punishment or freedom from the consequences of one's actions, particularly in the context of wrongdoing.

1. The corrupt officials acted with impunity, knowing they would face no consequences for their actions.
2. Despite the evidence against him, he seemed to commit crimes with impunity, evading justice at every turn.
3. The lack of enforcement allowed the company to pollute the river with impunity, harming the local ecosystem.
