Meaning: Imputation refers to the attribution of a fault, responsibility, or motive to someone, often without sufficient evidence.

1. The imputation of blame without evidence can lead to serious misunderstandings.
2. In the courtroom, the defense attorney challenged the imputation of motive by the prosecution.
3. Her imputation of dishonesty cast a shadow over his reputation.
4. The researcher faced criticism for the imputation of data that seemed too good to be true.
5. Imputation of responsibility in complex situations often requires careful analysis of all perspectives.
