Meaning: Imputative: relating to the attribution of responsibility or fault to someone, especially in a legal context.

1. The imputative nature of the evidence made it difficult to dismiss the allegations.
2. In legal contexts, imputative reasoning can significantly influence a jury's perception of intent.
3. The report presented imputative claims that suggested the company's negligence contributed to the accident.
4. Her imputative remarks about his character damaged their friendship beyond repair.
5. Imputative language in the media often shapes public opinion before all facts are known.
