1. She spoke inabusively during the meeting, making everyone uncomfortable.

3. He often treated his coworkers inabusively, causing high turnover in the department.
4. The teacher was warned about addressing students inabusively after several complaints.
5. Inabusively criticizing others only reflects poorly on one's character and leadership.
