Meaning: Inaquation refers to the incorrect or improper relationship or equation between two or more variables or elements.

1. The inaquation of the two variables in the experiment led to unexpected results.
2. Her inaquation of the budget projections raised concerns among the financial team.
3. The inaquation in his reasoning made it difficult to follow the logic of his argument.
4. An inaquation can sometimes reveal deeper insights into the relationships between different factors.
5. The researchers focused on the inaquation that could explain the discrepancies in their data.
