*Meaning: Inarticulated refers to expressing feelings or thoughts in a vague, unclear, or unformed manner, lacking coherent words or articulation.*

1. His emotions were so intense that they came out as inarticulated cries rather than coherent words.
2. The speaker struggled to convey her thoughts clearly, often resorting to inarticulated gestures.
3. Despite his inarticulated feelings, she could sense the depth of his affection.
4. The committee's inarticulated concerns about the project led to confusion among the team members.
