Meaning: INAUTHORITATIVE: lacking credibility or reliability; not recognized as a valid or trustworthy source of information.

1. The inauthoritative source failed to provide credible evidence for its claims.
2. Despite his loud assertions, his arguments remained inauthoritative and lacked substance.
3. Critics dismissed the report as inauthoritative due to its reliance on anecdotal evidence.
4. Her inauthoritative tone left the audience questioning her expertise on the subject.
5. In a debate, relying on inauthoritative figures can undermine one's overall argument.
