

INCAGE

Meaning: To incage means to confine or restrict someone or something within a cage or similar enclosure, often implying a sense of imprisonment or limitation.

1. The artist felt trapped in her own mind, as if her creativity was incaged by doubt.

3. The metaphor of being incaged resonated with many who felt confined by societal expectations.
