Meaning: Incarcerate: to confine or imprison someone, typically as a legal penalty for a crime.

1. The judge decided to incarcerate the defendant for a minimum of ten years.
2. Many activists believe that we should focus on rehabilitation rather than simply incarcerating offenders.
3. Incarcerating individuals without addressing the root causes of crime often leads to recidivism.
4. The documentary highlighted the harsh realities of being incarcerated in a maximum-security prison.
5. Efforts to reform the justice system often include measures to reduce the number of people we incarcerate.
