Meaning: Incenter (verb): to position or place something at the center of a space or composition.

1. The artist chose to incenter the main subject of her painting to draw the viewer's attention.
2. In the new design, the logo is incentered at the top of the page for better visibility.
3. They decided to incenter the table in the middle of the room to create a more inviting atmosphere.
4. During the presentation, it was crucial to incenter the key points for clarity.
5. The architect suggested incentering the fountain in the courtyard to enhance the landscape's symmetry.
