Meaning: Incircle (verb): To surround or enclose something in a circular manner, often to isolate or highlight it.

1. The strategy was designed to incircle the enemy's stronghold, cutting off all escape routes.
2. In the painting, the artist chose to incircle the central figure with vibrant colors to draw attention.
3. As the discussion progressed, it became clear that the main issue would incircle the topic of climate change.
4. The children decided to incircle the bonfire, sharing stories and laughter late into the night.
5. To create a sense of unity, the team formed a circle to incircle the project idea before presenting it.
