

INCLINING

Meaning: Inclining refers to the act of bending or leaning towards something, either physically, as in a tree reaching for sunlight, or metaphorically, as in adopting a particular viewpoint or attitude.

1. The tree was inclining towards the sunlight, its branches stretching out in search of warmth.
2. She found herself inclining to his perspective after hearing his thoughtful explanation.
3. The path was inclining steeply, making the hike more challenging than anticipated.
4. With each passing day, he felt his interests inclining more towards environmental science.
5. The artist's style has been inclining lately towards more abstract forms and vibrant colors.
6. The trees were inclining towards the river, drawn by the promise of water.
7. She found herself inclining to the idea of traveling abroad for the summer.
8. His body was inclining forward as he listened intently to the speaker.
9. The scientist's research was inclining toward a new understanding of climate change.
10. As the sun set, the mountains appeared to be inclining into the horizon.
