

INCRIMINATORY

Meaning: INCRIMINATORY: Adjective describing evidence or information that suggests or proves someone's involvement in a crime or wrongdoing.

1. The prosecutor presented incriminatory evidence that led to the suspect's arrest.
2. She felt the incriminatory photographs would ruin her reputation if they were made public.
3. During the trial, the defense attorney challenged the validity of the incriminatory documents.
4. His incriminatory remarks during the interview raised suspicions about his involvement in the crime.
5. The investigator carefully analyzed the incriminatory material to build a stronger case against the defendant.

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
