

INCULP

Meaning: Inculp (verb): to accuse or blame someone for a crime or wrongdoing.

1. The evidence presented was insufficient to inculp the defendant in the crime.
2. Her statements during the trial seemed designed to inculp her accomplice rather than herself.
3. The investigation aimed to inculp those responsible for the environmental disaster.
4. Despite the prosecutor's efforts, they could not find a way to inculp the suspect convincingly.
5. To inculp someone without solid proof could lead to serious legal repercussions.
