

# INCUSE

*Meaning: To incuse means to create a design or pattern by carving or impressing it into a surface, resulting in a recessed or indented effect.*

1. The artist decided to incuse intricate designs into the surface of the metal.
2. To create a unique texture, she chose to incuse the patterns rather than simply engrave them.
3. The ancient coins were often incused with symbols that represented various deities.
4. He meticulously incused the clay with various tools, achieving a stunning relief effect.
5. The technique of incusing has been used by artisans for centuries to add depth to their work.
