

INDEHISCENCE

Meaning: Indehiscence is the condition of fruits or seed pods that do not split open at maturity to release their seeds.

1. Indehiscence is a key characteristic of certain fruits, such as nuts, that do not open at maturity.
2. The indehiscence of the seed pods allows for prolonged protection of the seeds within.
3. Botanists study indehiscence to understand the evolutionary advantages it provides to various plant species.
4. In some plants, indehiscence ensures that seeds are dispersed gradually rather than all at once.
5. The concept of indehiscence contrasts sharply with that of dehiscence, where fruits split open to release seeds.

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
