

INDENTED

Meaning: Indented refers to having a space or notch created along the edge or margin, often used to describe paragraphs that are set in from the left margin or surfaces that are recessed or hollowed out.

1. The indented paragraphs in her essay made it easier to read and follow her arguments.
2. The old stone wall was indented in places, revealing signs of erosion over the years.
3. He noticed that the document had indented margins, which gave it a polished appearance.
4. The artist created an indented pattern on the clay, adding texture to her sculpture.
