*Meaning: INDENTING: The act of creating a space or notch by pushing in or cutting away material, often used in formatting text or shaping objects.*

1. Indenting the first line of each paragraph enhances the readability of the document.
2. The artist focused on indenting the edges of the sculpture to create a more dynamic shape.
3. She spent hours indenting the clay, carefully shaping it into a lifelike figure.
4. Indenting the fabric at the seams gave the dress a more tailored appearance.
5. The students practiced indenting their code to improve clarity and organization in their projects.
