*Meaning: Indictor: a sign or indicator that suggests or points to a particular condition or outcome, such as disease progression or guilt.*

1. The presence of certain biomarkers can act as an indictor of disease progression.
2. In the courtroom, the indictor of guilt is often based on the evidence presented by the prosecution.
3. He pointed to the rising crime rates as an indictor of the need for better community programs.
4. The financial report served as an indictor of the company's overall health and future prospects.
5. Her consistent attendance was an indictor of her commitment to the team and its goals.
