Meaning: Indignify means to deprive someone of their dignity or self-respect, often in a public manner.

1. To indignify someone is to strip away their dignity in a public setting.
2. The teacher's harsh remarks served to indignify the students in front of their peers.
3. In his quest for justice, he felt the need to indignify the corrupt officials who had betrayed the community.
4. It is never appropriate to indignify others, regardless of the circumstances.
5. Her goal was to empower those around her, not to indignify them through criticism.
