

INDILIGENCE

Meaning: Indilgence refers to a lack of diligence or care in one's work or responsibilities, resulting in neglect or poor performance.

1. Indilgence in his work led to missed deadlines and unfulfilled expectations.
2. Her indilgence was evident in the way she approached her studies, often leaving assignments until the last minute.
3. The project suffered due to the indilgence of its team members, who failed to contribute effectively.
4. Recognizing his indilgence, the manager scheduled a meeting to address the lack of productivity.
5. Indilgence can often be mistaken for a lack of interest, but it may also stem from deeper issues.
