Meaning: Indirected: characterized by subtle or implied criticism rather than direct accusation or reference.

1. The criticism was indirected, hinting at the flaws without naming anyone specifically.

3. The artist often used indirected approaches to convey his messages through symbolism.
4. In her speech, she made several indirected references to past events that shaped her views.
