Meaning: Ineligible: not qualified or permitted to participate or be considered for something, often due to specific criteria or requirements.

1. The student was deemed ineligible for the scholarship due to insufficient academic performance.
2. Due to the recent policy changes, many applicants found themselves suddenly ineligible for the program.
3. Her previous convictions made her ineligible for the job she had applied for.
4. The athlete was declared ineligible to compete after testing positive for a banned substance.
5. They were disappointed to learn that their financial situation rendered them ineligible for assistance.
