Meaning: INELLIGIBLY: in a manner that is impossible to understand or comprehend due to unclear expression or form.

1. His handwriting was so poorly formed that the notes were written intelligibly.
2. The lecturer spoke so quickly that much of his explanation came out intelligibly.
3. Despite her efforts to articulate her thoughts, she expressed them intelligibly.
4. The audio recording was damaged, making the speaker's words come through intelligibly.
5. As he struggled with his emotions, his response became increasingly intelligibly.
