Meaning: Inexcusable: impossible to justify or excuse; deserving condemnation for a serious lapse in conduct or responsibility.

1. Her lack of preparation for the important presentation was simply inexcusably unprofessional.
2. The delay in responding to the emergency was deemed inexcusably negligent by the committee.
3. He found her excuses for missing the meeting to be inexcusably weak and disappointing.
4. The teacher considered cheating on the exam to be an inexcusably serious offense.
5. It was inexcusably rude of him to interrupt her while she was speaking.
