

# INFARCT

*Meaning: Infarct: a localized area of tissue death (necrosis) due to the obstruction of blood supply.*

1. The doctor explained that an infarct occurs when blood flow to a part of the heart is blocked.
2. After the stroke, the MRI revealed a significant infarct in the right hemisphere of the brain.
3. Tim's sudden chest pain was later diagnosed as a myocardial infarct.
4. Understanding the risk factors for an infarct can help in preventing serious cardiovascular events.
5. The patient's recovery was complicated by a large infarct that affected his mobility and speech.
