Meaning: Inference: a conclusion reached based on evidence and reasoning rather than explicit statements.

2. In literature, readers often make inferences to understand characters' motivations.

4. Her lack of evidence made his inference seem hasty and unfounded.
5. Drawing an inference from the data requires a keen analytical mind.
