Meaning: Inferentially: in a manner that involves drawing conclusions or making deductions based on evidence or reasoning rather than explicit statements.

1. The researchers concluded, inferentially, that the drug would be effective based on the initial trial results.
2. He was able to grasp the underlying themes of the novel inferentially, without direct explanation from the author.
3. The detective pieced together the clues inferentially, arriving at a solution that surprised everyone.
4. In the lecture, the professor demonstrated how to approach philosophical arguments inferentially rather than literally.
5. They inferentially deduced the company's financial health from its recent stock market performance.
