Meaning: Inferred: deduced or concluded information based on evidence or reasoning rather than explicit statements.

1. The detective inferred the suspect's guilt from the evidence presented at the scene.
2. From her tone and body language, I inferred that she was not happy with the decision.
3. Scientists have inferred the presence of water on Mars based on satellite images.
4. He inferred her lack of response as a sign of disinterest in the conversation.
5. Based on their previous interactions, she inferred that he was not telling the whole truth.
