*Meaning: Inflected refers to the modification of a word, particularly a verb or noun, to express grammatical features such as tense, case, or number.*

1. The verb was inflected to match the tense of the narrative.
2. In Latin, nouns are often inflected to indicate case and number.

4. The teacher explained how the word changes when it is inflected for plurality.
