Meaning: Inflex (verb): To bend or curve something, often to alter its form or structure, or to modify established rules or norms for a different effect or outcome.

1. The artist chose to inflex the metal sculpture to create a more dynamic shape.
2. Inflexing the rules of the game can lead to unexpected outcomes that challenge players.
3. The dancer's ability to inflex her body with such grace captivated the audience.
4. To inflex the fabric correctly, she practiced various folding techniques before the presentation.
