Meaning: To inflict means to cause something unpleasant or harmful to be experienced by someone.

1. The new policy may inflict unnecessary stress on employees.
2. He did not intend to inflict pain, but his words came out harshly.
3. They feared that the storm could inflict serious damage on the coastline.
4. The punishment was meant to inflict a lesson on those who broke the rules.
5. Her criticism could inflict deep emotional wounds that take time to heal.
