Meaning: Informer: a person who provides privileged information, especially to law enforcement or authorities, often about criminal activities, while maintaining secrecy about their identity.

1. The police relied on the informer to provide crucial details about the gang's activities.
2. As an informer, she had to be careful not to reveal her identity to those she was spying on.
3. He acted as an informer for the local newspaper, uncovering stories that others had missed.
4. The informer faced significant risks, knowing that betrayal could lead to severe consequences.
