*Meaning: Infringer: a person or entity that violates or encroaches upon the rights or protections granted by law, such as copyright or patent rights.*

1. The court ruled that the company was an infringer of the copyright held by the artist.
2. As an infringer of patent rights, the startup faced a hefty lawsuit from the established corporation.
3. She was labeled an infringer after using the song without obtaining the necessary licenses.
4. The local business became an inadvertent infringer when it copied elements from a competitor's branding.
5. Infringers of trademark laws often face severe penalties to deter future violations.
