*Meaning: Infula: a sacred headband or fillet worn by ancient Roman priests as a symbol of their religious authority.*

1. The ancient Roman priest wore an infula as a symbol of his office during religious ceremonies.

3. The infula, traditionally made of wool, was draped over the shoulders to signify purity and devotion.
