Meaning: Ingeminate: to repeat or reiterate something for emphasis or clarity.

1. The teacher chose to ingeminate the key concepts to ensure the students grasped the material thoroughly.
2. As the debate progressed, he began to ingeminate his main arguments for greater emphasis.
3. In her speech, she decided to ingeminate the importance of kindness in the community.
4. The author would often ingeminate critical themes throughout the narrative to reinforce their significance.
5. To drive the point home, the coach would ingeminate the same strategies until they became second nature to the players.
