Meaning: Ingrapple means to engage in a struggle or conflict, either physically, as in wrestling, or mentally, as in dealing with complex emotions.

1. The two wrestlers began to ingrapple, their bodies twisting as they fought for control.
2. In grappling with his emotions, he found it difficult to express his true feelings.
3. As the debate continued, the politicians ingrappled over the implications of their policies.
4. The children ingrappled in a playful manner, their laughter echoing in the park.
5. She found herself ingrappling with the complexities of adult life and her responsibilities.
