

INJUNCTION

Meaning: An injunction is a legal order issued by a court requiring a party to do or refrain from doing a specific act.

1. The court issued an injunction to prevent the company from continuing its harmful practices.
2. After a lengthy trial, the judge granted an injunction to stop the construction of the building.
3. The environmental group sought an injunction against the factory to protect the local wildlife.
4. An injunction was necessary to ensure that the rights of the tenants were upheld during the eviction process.
5. Despite their efforts, the plaintiffs were unable to secure an injunction to halt the project in time.
