3. The new policy was injuriously affecting the morale of the employees, leading to increased turnover.
4. Injurious to both the environment and human health, the factory's emissions sparked widespread outrage.
5. If not handled carefully, the medication could injuriously interact with other prescriptions, causing serious side effects.
